This letter is submitted on behalf of Josiaine Dias de Oliveira, to formally notify this office of her intent to withdraw the above-referenced Form I-589, Application for Asylum and for Withholding of Removal, received by USCIS on January 26, 2024, under Receipt Number LGL2490086383. The application was filed on behalf of Ms. Dias de Oliveira and her two minor children as beneficiaries: Marcos Elpidio Carvalho Dias de Oliveira (A242-275-982) and Kayo Alipio Carvalho Dias de Oliveira Neto (A242-275-983).

Ms. Dias de Oliveira is no longer seeking asylum in the United States and has returned to Brazil. Her dependent beneficiaries, Marcos Elpidio Carvalho Dias de Oliveira and Kayo Alipio Carvalho Dias de Oliveira Neto, have likewise departed the United States and returned to Brazil with her. As such, neither the principal applicant nor her derivative beneficiaries intend to pursue asylum protection in the United States.

She has been fully advised of all consequences of this withdrawal, including the withdrawal and closure of the application without a merits determination, the termination of derivative protection for her dependent beneficiaries, and the effect upon any Employment Authorization Documents issued pursuant to 8 C.F.R. § 208.7. She has expressly authorized the undersigned to submit this request on her behalf.

Enclosed please find Ms. Dias de Oliveira's signed Declaration of Intent to Withdraw Asylum Application.

We respectfully request confirmation of receipt and written notice of the withdrawal and closure of this case. Please direct any further correspondence to the undersigned.

DECLARATION OF INTENT TO WITHDRAW ASYLUM APPLICATION

Form I-589 - Application for Asylum and for Withholding of Removal

I, Josiaine Dias de Oliveira (A242-275-981) hereby expressly authorize my attorney of record, Otavio Haverroth Silva, Esq. (CA Bar No. 343486), to submit this withdrawal request to the USCIS San Francisco Asylum Office on my behalf, including any and all related correspondence and documentation necessary to effectuate the closure of the above-referenced application.

I wish to withdraw my application for asylum because I am no longer seeking asylum in the United States. I have returned to Brazil and do not wish to continue pursuing this application.

I understand that by doing so I will close the application permanently, and will not be able to reopen it. If I wish to be considered for asylum at a later date I will have to file a new Form I-589, Application for Asylum and for Withholding of Removal, subject to the laws and regulations in place at the time of filing any new application, including any restrictions on filing.

I understand that by withdrawing my application for asylum any dependent family members and I may be placed in proceedings before an immigration judge.

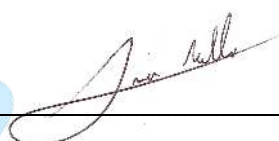
I understand that because I will no longer have an application for asylum pending before U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS), I will not be entitled to asylum-based employment authorization. I understand that after withdrawal of my application, I cannot obtain or renew my Employment Authorization Document on the basis of my asylum claim.

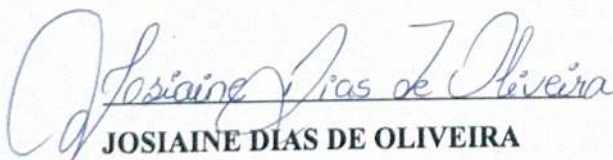

Your complete Form I-589, Application for Asylum and for Withholding of Removal was received and is pending as of 01/26/2024.

You may remain in the United States until your asylum application is decided. Having a pending asylum application with USCIS does not preclude U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) or U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) from placing you into removal proceedings. If you wish to leave the United States while your application is pending, you must obtain advance parole or, for Temporary Protected Status (TPS) recipients, approval of Form I-512T, Authorization for Travel by a Noncitizen to the United States (sometimes referred to as MTINA TPS travel authorization), from USCIS or you may be considered to have abandoned your asylum application. You must report a change of address to USCIS within 10 days of moving by following the instructions on the How to Change Your Address webpage (<https://www.uscis.gov/addresschange>). Changing your address with the U.S. Postal Service will not change your address with USCIS.

BIOMETRICS APPOINTMENT AND ASYLUM INTERVIEW NOTICES:

You will receive a notice informing you when you and those listed on your application as a spouse or child dependent must appear at an Application Support Center (ASC) for biometrics collection. You will also receive a notice informing you when you and those listed on your application as a spouse or child dependent must appear for an asylum interview. Those notices will contain instructions for what to bring to your ASC appointment and what to bring to your asylum interview.

WARNING: Failure to appear at the ASC for biometrics collection or for your asylum interview may affect your eligibility for employment authorization and may also result in the dismissal of your asylum application or referral of your asylum application to an immigration judge.

EMPLOYMENT AUTHORIZATION:

You may file a Form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization, based on your pending asylum application 150 days after you filed your asylum application. You are not eligible to receive an Employment Authorization Document (EAD) until your asylum application has been pending for at least another 30 days, for a total of 180 days. 8 CFR 208.7(a)(1). The 150-day waiting period and the 180-day eligibility period, commonly referred to as the 180-Day Asylum EAD Clock, do not include delays that you request or cause while your asylum application is pending with an asylum office or with the Immigration Court. 8 CFR 208.7(a)(2).

Delays requested or caused by the applicant may include:

- A request to transfer a case to a new asylum office or interview location, including when the transfer is based on your change of address;
- A request to reschedule an interview for a later date;
- Failure to appear at an interview or biometrics appointment;
- Failure to provide a competent interpreter at an interview (if required);
- A request to provide additional evidence at or after an interview;
