RESPONDENT'S SUBMISSION OF FORM EOIR-28

Undersigned Counsel, Otavio Haverroth Silva, respectfully submits this Form EOIR-28 (Notice of Entry of Appearance as Attorney or Representative Before the Immigration Court) and requests that it be accepted and docketed into the Record of Proceedings based on the following grounds:

Undersigned Counsel timely submitted Form EOIR-28 concurrently with Respondent's Motion to Reopen on June 16, 2026, via the EOIR Court Access and System (ECAS) portal. Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a copy of the ECAS electronic submission demonstrating the timely transmission of this filing along with the Motion to Reopen and additional evidence.

Nonetheless, upon recent inquiry with the Clerk of the Court, Counsel was informed that **no entry of appearance currently appears in the official Record of Proceedings** and counsel was not entered as attorney of record for the Respondent.

Consequently, Counsel lacks electronic access to the Record of Proceedings (ROP) via ECAS and is unable to receive service of orders, hearing notices, or official court communications regarding Respondent's pending matter.

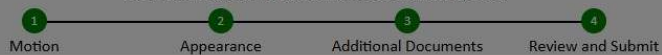
