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RESPONDENT’S MOTION TO CHANGE VENUE

Respectfully, the Respondent requests the Immigration Judge to transfer the venue of her ongoing removal proceedings from the Immigration Court situated at Miami, FL, to the Immigration Court that has jurisdiction over the address mentioned below. The Immigration Court holds the discretion to allow the change of venue "for good cause" under 8 C.F.R. §1003.20 (b).

1. This matter is currently scheduled for a Master Hearing on **August 19, 2026, at 10:30 AM.**
2. The Respondent's current address of residence is the following: **1920 Ortega St., San Francisco, CA 94122.** See Exhibit 1.
3. The Respondent is filing, contemporaneously with this motion, an EOIR-33 Change of Address reflecting the new residence.
4. The Respondent recently retained undersigned counsel, whose office is also located in California, to represent her in these proceedings.

Good cause exists because Respondent now permanently resides within a distinct jurisdiction. Requiring Respondent to continue litigating the case in Miami would impose significant financial and logistical burdens, including the necessity of cross-country travel for hearings.

Transferring venue will promote judicial efficiency by allowing proceedings to occur in the jurisdiction where Respondent resides, where future hearings can be attended more easily, and where any witnesses or supporting evidence are more readily available.

Granting this motion will not prejudice the Department of Homeland Security. Rather, it will facilitate Respondent's appearance at future hearings and promote the orderly administration of these proceedings.

Consequently, the Respondent respectfully requests the court to grant this petition to transfer venue.
